serendipity

Part of Speech: noun

Definition: The occurrence of events by chance in a happy or beneficial way.

Example: Her discovery of the hidden café was pure serendipity.

ephemeral

Part of Speech: adjective

Definition: Lasting for a very short time; transitory.

Example: Fashion trends are often ephemeral, changing with each season.

resilience

Part of Speech: noun

Definition: The capacity to recover quickly from difficulties; toughness.

Example: Children often show remarkable resilience in the face of change.

quandary

Part of Speech: noun

Definition: A state of perplexity or uncertainty over what to do in a difficult situation.

Example: She was in a quandary about choosing between two job offers.

luminous

Part of Speech: adjective

Definition: Full of or shedding light; bright or shining, especially in the dark.

Example: The luminous glow of the lanterns lit up the night path.
